Find things to build with - Lego/Duplo/Blocks/cushions and pillows/ packets from the cupboards/plastic boxes, bowls, cups...

Look at all the different shapes, colours, textures (feels). Pretend they are all the different people in the world who love and follow Jesus.

Without Jesus and what He has done for us, we would not be His living Church.

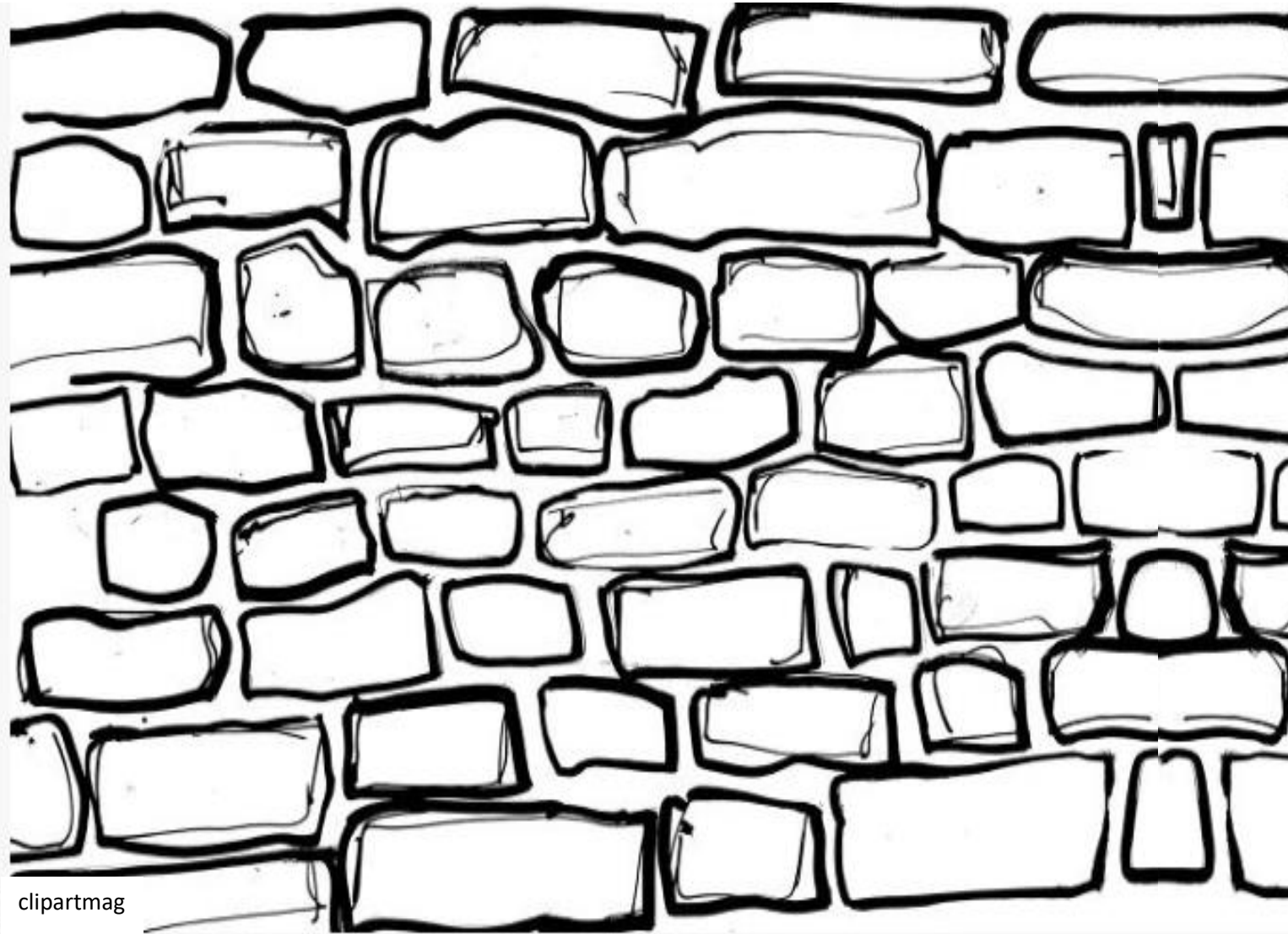
Idea 2

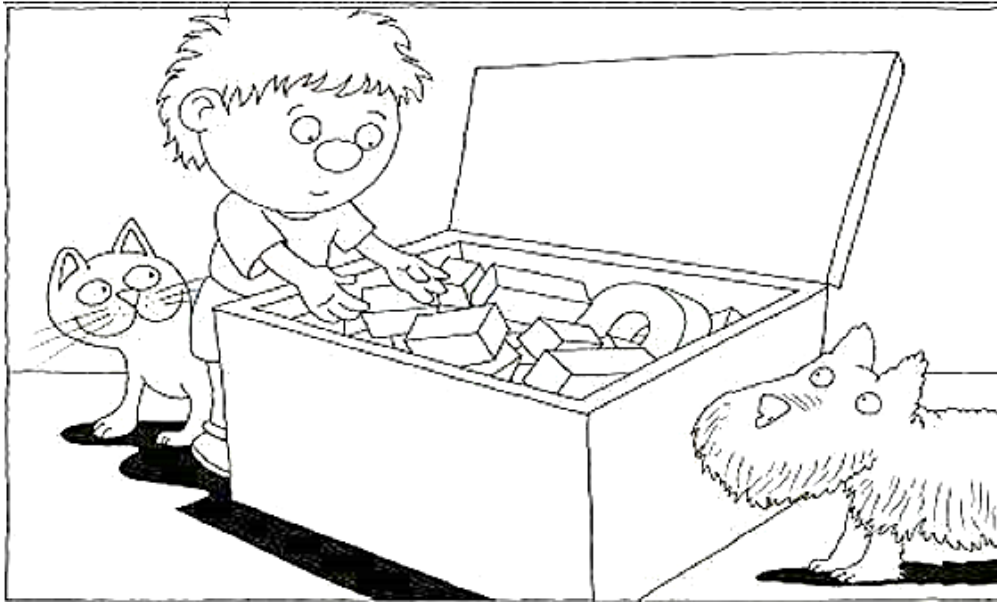

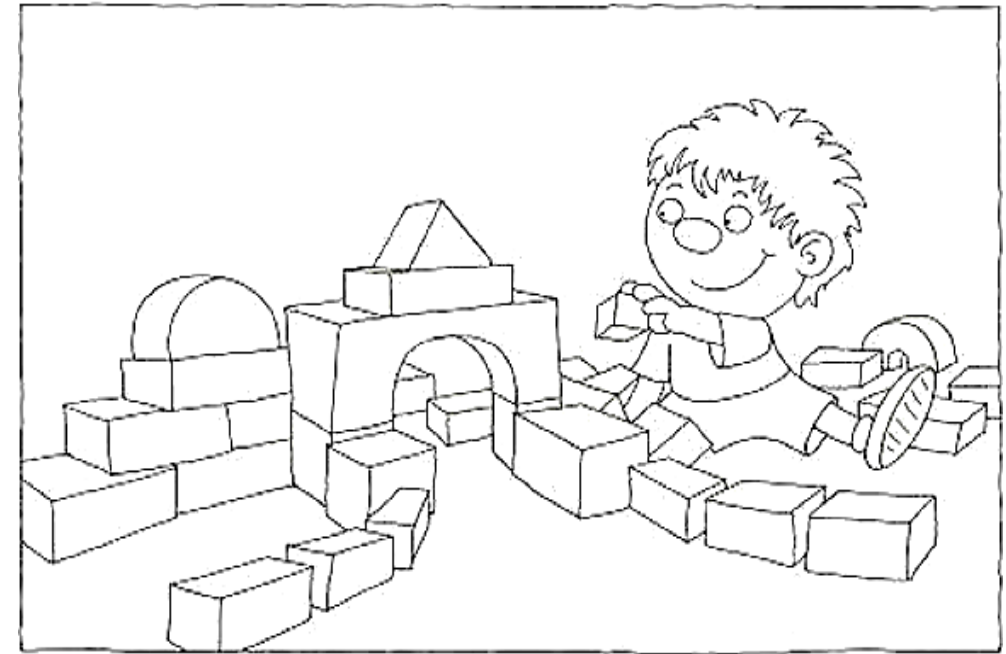
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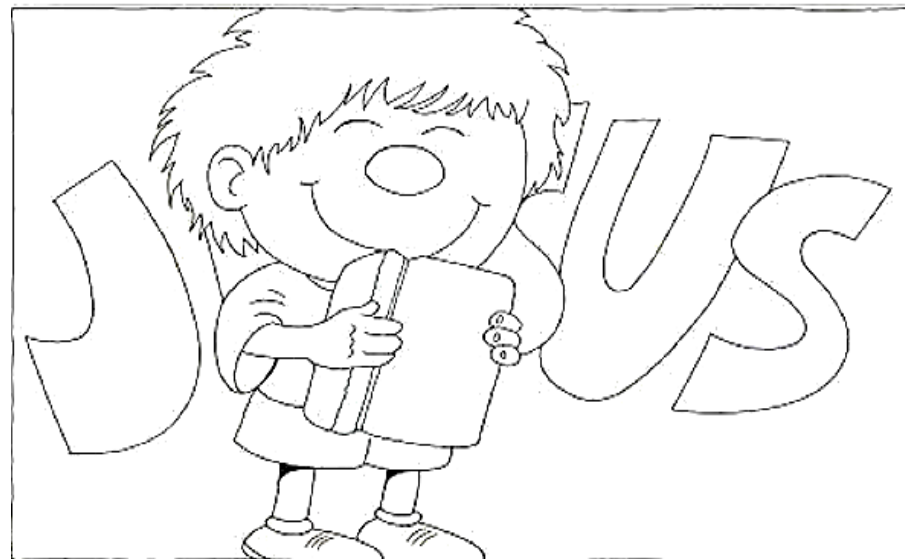
