Who had more than enough?

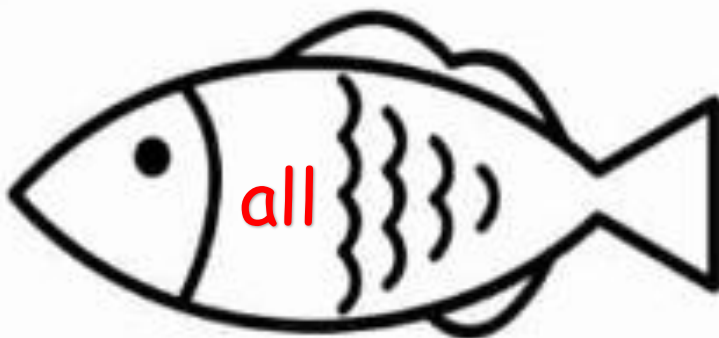
How many baskets of left-overs were collected up afterwards?

Jesus is more than enough. There is nothing that is too big or too small for Him to help and guide us with.

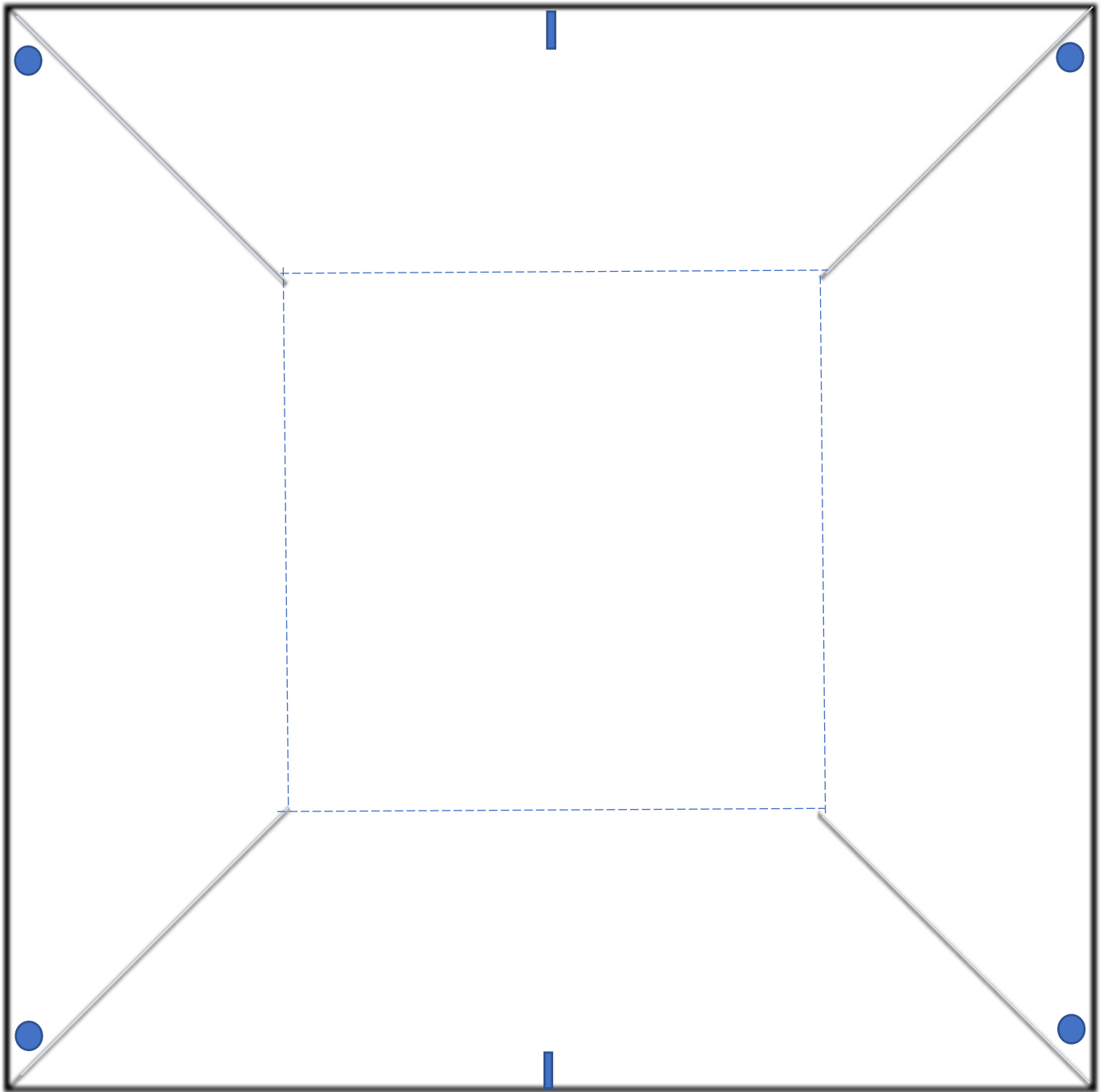
Carefully colour and cut out the loaves and fishes on this page

Handle

Cut out the square basket and the handle. Carefully cut along the solid diagonal lines on the basket. Fold along the dotted lines. Now staple the 2 adjacent dots to the marked centre line. Repeat with the other side of the basket. Pinch the corners of the basket to square it up. Glue or staple the handle in place - see picture on previous page.
